### FREE FLOWING WATERCOLORS with Janice Castiglione

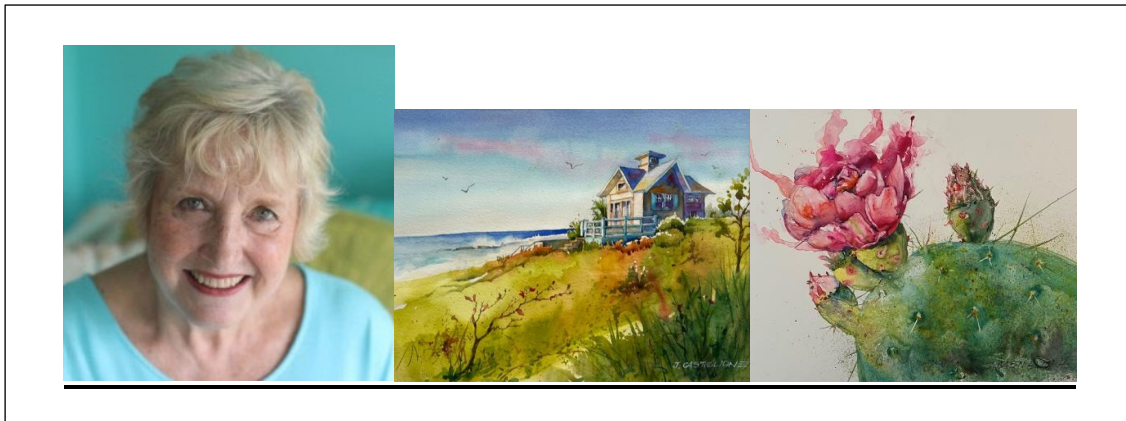
Friday & Saturday, April 28 – 29, 2023

#### Workshop Description

Participants will explore the excitement of watercolor, letting the paint do what no other medium can do: flow, drip, granulate and evolve. Each class will begin with a warm up with basic watercolor practices, followed by a demonstration.

**Day1-** we will work together on all the aspects of landscape painting, skies, trees, foliage and buildings. Also covering the elements of composition, to push things back into the distance and bring other elements forward creating an illusion of depth. After practicing the elements, we will attempt to put them together to create a final landscape painting.

**Day 2-** Fun with Yupo. We will paint with watercolor paints and watercolor supplies on this archival plastic paper. No alcohol inks. The watercolor paint does not soak into the paper leaving a lot of time to manipulate and create!



#### About the Instructor

Growing up in Western New York, Janice lived above her family's tavern. Although a lot of activity surrounded her, she was often bored and would amuse herself by drawing for hours at the restaurant's dining room table. Janice went on to earn a bachelor's degree from Empire State College in Illustration and Graphic Design.

## **Supply List**

This is a list of supplies to get you started. You can substitute comparable materials. The instructor will try to make whatever supplies you have work. Paper and decent brushes make a big difference. Along with WC supplies you need Yupo paper and a small spray bottle of 90% alcohol. Available at Walgreens or any drug store. If you don't want to buy a whole pad of YUPO paper Janice will have some sheets to sell. 9"X 12" - Heavy (\$2.20 each) and medium (\$1.20)

### **Watercolor Paint:**

Winsor & Newton brand -Janice uses professional grade but you can use student grade. The difference is student grade has less pigment in them and don't last as long.

Paints: Cadmium yellow, Quinacridone gold, Cadmium orange, Cadmium red, Alizarin Crimson, Yellow ochre (or Raw Sienna), Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Phthalo green (winsor green), French Ultramarine blue, Turquoise blue

### **Other Supplies:**

- Watercolor palette (John Pike or something like it)
- Tape (masking or painters)
- HB pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- \*Medium or heavy yupo paper
- Arches 140# watercolor paper cold press
- Watercolor Brushes-
  - 1" flat brush
  - #12, #8 & #2 round brushes- recommend Black velvet silver brand- great brush for price. More can be added when needed.
- Mounting Board for painting on- Plexiglas, gatorboard, Masonite. Approx.- 18"X 24"
- Viva paper towels
- Small water spray bottle
- Salt
