After retiring as the Art Dept Chair at UNCP, she moved to Wilmington. She continues to produce works which have been shown in over 250 shows and also collected extensively in over 40 public museums, public venues, colleges and universities and in many private galleries nationally and internationally principally in Germany, France, The Netherlands, Canada, Bulgaria, Italy, Denmark and the US.
